

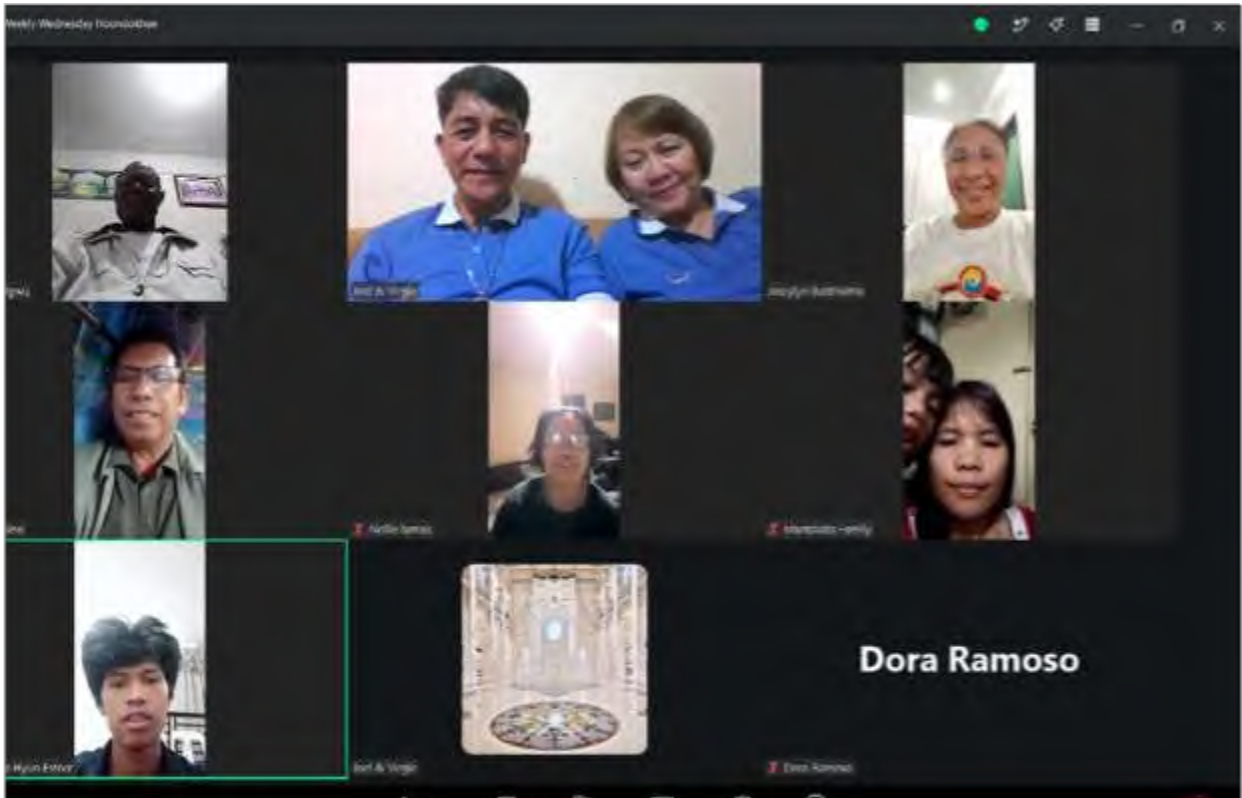
FFWPU Cavite, Philippines Church holds its 940th Hoon Dok Hae
