

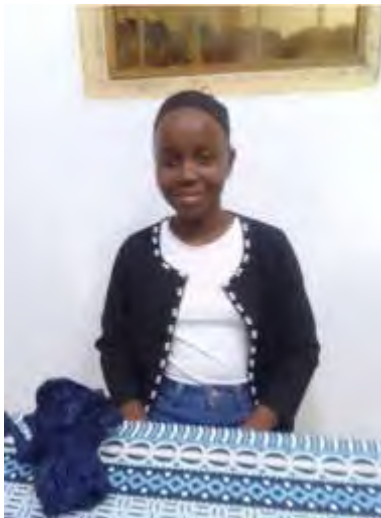
WFPV USA: Raise a New Generation of Doctors Rise at Sun of Mozambique Secondary School

Dear,

When Ana Paula was a student at Sun of Mozambique Junior and Senior High School, she had a dream: **to become a doctor.**



She worked hard throughout her years at the school, consistently achieving top grades. After graduating in 2024, her dedication paid off—she was accepted into a medical program at the Catholic University.

Today, Ana Paula is one step closer to the dream she has carried since childhood. And she isn't the first student from Sun of Mozambique to pursue a career in medicine.

Since the school opened in 1995, **19 graduates have gone on to become doctors**, including one woman. They are now contributing to the health and development of Mozambique, with some even serving beyond the country's borders.

One of those graduates, Dr. Filipe Chorocho Mucondua, has practiced medicine for 20 years and recently participated in a medical support project in São Tomé and Príncipe. And today, another young woman is dreaming of following in their footsteps.

One woman has already become a doctor. Another young girl is dreaming of becoming one.

Your support helps make those dreams possible—not only through education, but by helping provide the everyday necessities that allow a school to function and students to focus on learning.

This past year, WFWP USA provided \$3,000 to help install a water tank and repair the school's photocopier. Something as simple as running water can make an enormous difference.



Before the new water tank was installed, water in Beira was available only in the mornings. Students and teachers who had afternoon classes often struggled to use the toilets and sinks. Now, the school has reliable water throughout the day, improving hygiene and creating a more comfortable environment for everyone.

The school is also looking toward the future, considering a solar power system that could help reduce electricity costs and provide power during outages.

This is what your support does. It helps create the conditions where students can learn, teachers can teach, and young people can pursue dreams that may one day change their communities.

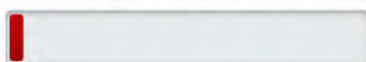

2026 UPDATES

- **\$5,000** sent in March 2026 and **\$3,000** in September 2025 to the **Sun of Mozambique Secondary School** for their **general administrative costs, to install a water tank for the toilets, and purchase new photocopy machines**. This year they have 520 students attending the school.
- **\$11,000** sent in March 2026 to the New Hope Technical Training Institute in **Rwanda** for the **"Women's Startup Empowerment Project 2026"**, a structured program including a business boot camp, one-on-one mentorship, and a final pitch competition to support a select group of social entrepreneurs
- **\$6,000** sent in September 2025 to **New Hope Technical Training Institute in Rwanda** to **purchase necessary training supplies** for culinary arts, beautician, and tailoring courses; these tools are invaluable for the students to practice what they are learning
 - **additional \$8,000** sent in December 2025 to the **New Hope Technical Training Institute** to fund **3 additional specialized trainings** for students to help them be more competitive upon graduation and boost the **daily lunch** so students have nutrition to focus on their studies
- **\$7,800** sent in September 2026 to **Handow Secondary School in Kenya** to **renovate their dilapidated dining hall**
- **\$3,000** sent in September 2025 to **Sunac Elementary School in Guinea Bissau** to **paint and repair their classrooms**

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
